

Winter Check List

Do a floor heat check up.

- Check the solution level in your floor heat system.
- Check the oil level in the pump. Add oil or replace if needed.
- Start and run the floor heat system until it shuts off automatically. This will help make sure it is working properly.
- Check heater ventilation for obstructions. Birds nests, debris, other damage, etc...

Do a wash bay check up.

- Check for leaks in you car wash bays.
- Check your weep system. Check the temperature settings and calibrate if needed.
- Check and clean the weep system solenoid.
- Replace the weep system battery.
- Check the trough heat to make sure the line won't freeze.
- Make sure bay doors are working properly.
- Switch to winter formula chemicals for foam brush and tri-foam.
- Check your coin box heaters to be sure they are working.
- Make sure all temperature monitors are working.

Do an outside check up.

- Check that you have plenty of ice melt on hand. Use a quality sodium based product to help protect your concrete. Rock salt can damage concrete.
- Verify your snow removal contract or if you remove snow your self check the condition of your snow removal equipment.
- Change to winter formula in the fragrance dispensers.
- Change to winter formula in carpet shampoo machines.
